Dear Students, Parents and Guardians

We would like to provide some basic information regarding the Air Force Junior ROTC program at Flower Mound High School to help you consider trying our program for the 2024-2025 school year. The mission of AFJROTC is to "Develop citizens of character dedicated to serving their nation and community."

First, you should know that this program <u>DOES NOT</u> create a military obligation. Our program is designed to develop leadership and followership skills within our cadets to help them in adult life.

For those who are interested in a military career, this program is a terrific way to get your child ready for joining the military right after high school, the ROTC route, or any other road they choose to take.

Our corps of cadets is strong and getting stronger. For instance, in the past 6 years, 13 cadets have earned their private pilot license free of charge. In addition, our Joint Leadership & Academic Bowl team has reached the national finals—with a free trip to Washington DC, in 5 of the last 12 years.

AFJROTC can be balanced with other extra-curricular activities. We have many cadets who simultaneously participate in sports, band, orchestra and other FMHS programs. One benefit of this, AFJROTC is one of the most diverse groups at FMHS.

Some other benefits that our program offers:

- Earn your PE or elective credits
- Participate in our away and local trips
- Earn a letterman jacket (Sophomore-Senior Year)

- Corps parties and social events
- Annual military ball
- Numerous community service opportunities
- Participation in competitions
- Optional leadership camp every summer
- Scholarship opportunities
- Possible FREE private pilots license

The AFJROTC program offers new cadets the option to defer wearing the uniform during their first semester, providing them with a smoother transition into the program. After that, adherence to grooming standards is required to maintain a professional appearance. As a part of a weekly activity they will be required to participate in certain physical training activities.

AFJROTC has a dedicated classroom, multipurpose room, and dressing/uniform room. Students may join AFJROTC at any point in their high school career.

AFJROTC sponsors a summer program for cadets to earn a private pilot's license completely free. At the age of just 17 your child could be flying planes solo.

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
