LISD School Health Advisory Council Minutes

L. Call to Order @ 6:06pm

A. Opening remarks were made by Gala Langley. She shared that the meeting was an open forum, and informed council members to use the microphone as the meeting was being recorded.

II. Approval of Minutes

A. There was a 1st and 2nd for the approval of the May 10th meeting minutes and the motion to approve carried.

III. Child Nutrition – R. Danilowicz, Child Nutrition

A. A quick video was viewed that highlighted the ways in which the Child Nutrition Department is promoting children to eat more fruits and vegetables.

IV. New Business

- A. Returning for SHAC 2023 School Year Ms. Vincelette asked for all of our current members to consider returning for SY 2023 since we have not completed our task of recommending curriculum for the ES and MS Human Sexuality TEKS. A Google form will be going out to give a status for council members for next year.
- B. Sub-Committee Breakout
 - 1. All three teams broke out to have about 30-40 minutes of discussion time and conversations were recorded.
- C. Sub-Committee Report Out
 - 1. Recommendations to Council
 - a) Secondary Growth and Development J. Beimer shared that the subcommittee will gain more feedback and insight on the Middle Growth and Development curricula. She shared that the subcommittee agrees unanimously that the Goodheart Willcox companion text for High School Health is aligned to the TEKS, contains content that is appropriate for the grade levels in which it would be taught, and reflects the LISD community values. We would like to file a motion for the SHAC to recommend Goodheart Willcox as a resource to support the high school Health TEKS in the Reproductive and Sexual Health strand and send it forward to the school board for consideration and approval. Motion was received. Jennifer Beimer made the first motion and it was seconded by Nannie Boone; motion carried with a unanimous vote.
 - b) Senate Bill 9 E. Walter shared that the committee unanimously agrees to make a motion to recommend that the district keep the current programing (Second Step and Everfi) and add The Children's Advocacy Center of North Texas supplementary curricula in response to Senate Bill 9 established by the Texas Education Agency; the second was received from 888; motion carried with a unanimous vote.

- c) Elementary Growth and Development M. Vincelette recapped that the committee unanimously agreed to recommend that the district continue with the current video "Always Changing" for the 5th grade for the 2022-23 school year with this subcommittee continuing its evaluation of the content that meets the revised TEKS for the 4th and 5th grade during the 2022 -23 school year. Ms. Vincelette made the motion and it was seconded by T. Chulick; motion carried with a unanimous vote.
