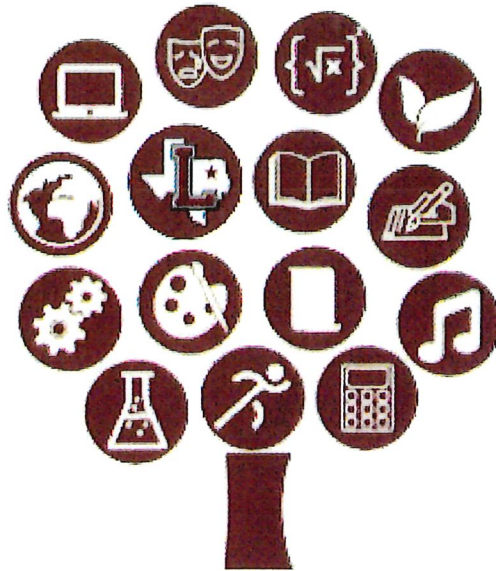

2025-2026 REGISTRATION BASICS

Part 1

Step 1: Go to SCHEDULE in your **STUDENT** Skyward. You **cannot** select courses in PARENT Skyward.

Step 2: Select COURSE REQUESTS 2025-2026 on the upper right hand side of your current schedule.

Step 3: Using the course cards provided in this packet, type in the **course number** listed before your desired course. Select and ADD the course to your request. .

Step 4: Once selected and added, the course will populate to the left column.

Step 5: Once 8 credits worth of courses are entered, you are done selecting your first choice course.

Part 2

Step 1: Switch screen by selecting ALTERNATES 2025-2026 along the top.

Step 2: Using the same process, select 4 more credits worth of courses for your Alternate options.

Could be alternates for an elective, or a science. **CANNOT** be a Career Center Classes or Athletics.

Alternates are an additional 4 credits/courses that you would be interested in taking.

In many cases, these 2nd option courses are used in your future schedule. Select wisely.

Step 3: You are **DONE** when you have completed both Part 1 and Part 2 (8 credits and 4 alternates).

There is not a save button. The courses you added to your future schedule are automatically saved once SELECTED COURSES and ALTERNATES in Skyward.

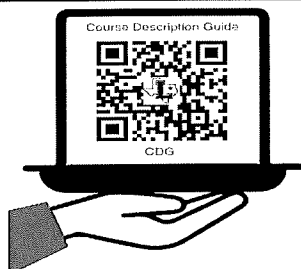

How does it work?

All VLA courses are robust, reviewed and available for students to earn up to 3 original course credits per school year. All VLA courses are taught by certified, LISD teachers who are highly trained in methods of online instruction and engagement. The VLA offers a wide range of core subject area courses as well as electives providing many options for your student's learning.

Fees?

Courses taken during the school day are provided at no additional cost to LISD students. If your student takes a VLA course outside of the school day or during the summer, an additional fee will be assessed.

VLA COURSE OFFERINGS AND REGISTRATION
