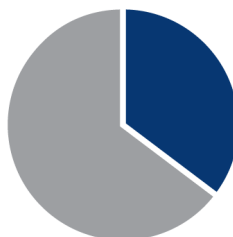
We will continue to challenge our students to strive for excellence in character, scholarship, fine arts, athletics, and contributing to their community.



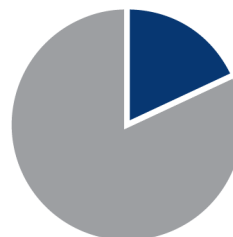
ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

PSAT SCORES AND ADVANCED COURSES

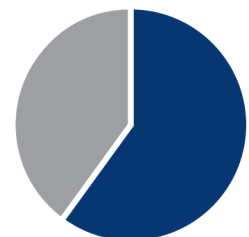
- = Percent of students whose PSAT test scores indicate they are college and career ready.
