

CBC Questions from Meeting #10 - September 18

Question	Response
<p>Should all of the vestibules be working by now? CBC Member has been to Creekside 3 times and the security vestibule has been down each time..... Believes staff has not yet adapted to it so his child exited out a different door.</p> <p>LHS Killough had a user issue for the vestibule.</p>	<p>The district will review these two campuses ASAP and continues to work with staff for consistency of operation.</p>
<p>Does updating the paging system also fix external sound quality with external paging systems? External paging speakers may not be loud enough and it might be speaker location issue.</p>	<p>Replacing the main paging system likely will not improve the sound quality of the external speaker. There might be some configuration possible to increase amperage to that speaker. LISD Technology will review the location of the speaker to see if the issue can be resolved now. A Technology support ticket has been created for this concern.</p>
<p>When will TECC-W open?</p>	<p>August 2020</p>
<p>When does construction start in the morning at Hedrick MS? One day (only), backup alarms were heard around 5:00 in the morning.</p>	<p>7am is the City of Lewisville's start time by ordinance but that variances are requested from time to time for earlier concrete pours.</p>
<p>How many people fit in the storm shelter at Vickery?</p>	<p>1,056 occupants</p>
<p>Could the community take shelter in the storm shelters? Has the district taken a position on this? For example, during pickup time?</p>	<p>Yes, any community members at the campus at the time when the shelter is activated, would shelter with the campus in the storm shelter area; however, the shelter would not be open to the community to travel to the campus and shelter. The shelter serves the occupants of the building at the time of need.</p>
<p>There are pickup/drop off issues at Vickery...with 200-300 kids parking capacity is an issue. Are there any considerations to expand the parking lot at Vickery?</p>	<p>No, additional parking was requested. Yet, after reviewing the campus, it was determined it had comparable number of parking spaces when compared to other ES campuses of similar capacity. Matt Garrett explained that all ES campuses experience parking issues during large events.</p>
<p>When will tennis courts be ready at Hebron?</p>	<p>October 10, 2019</p>
<p>Are the parking issues at Hebron being taken care of?</p>	<p>Yes, the initial concerns were addressed with the contractor who minimized the number of spaces needed for construction. Also, the construction workers are being shuttled to the campus from across Hebron Parkway.</p>
<p>Do we still allow principals to pick interior colors?</p>	<p>No, we allow principal input but provide options that are in the neutral palettes which we have found to be much more timeless. LISD also</p>

	directs the architects to use color on building components that are easily changed such as paint and not on components that are difficult or expensive to change such as wall panels, etc.
Regarding new library designs at Valley Ridge: does having only the bookcases as the barrier around the library allow sound travel and is it disruptive?	It was discussed that one of the big focuses at the STEM campuses was collaboration and that opening up these spaces invited that collaboration. It was also discussed that these spaces are being utilized for so much more than the “library” of the past. It was also pointed out that in Valley Ridge we did enclose part of the space for a reading nook, storytime, or break out space.
Did the Student Support Services building sell?	Yes.
Is there another demographic study coming up?	Templeton Demographics provides an update to the district quarterly. The 3rd quarter update is our most critical as it includes Snapshot data data which drives the projections for the coming school year.
Are there more projects than what were on the year 3 list?	The remaining bond projects are planned to start in year 4 (2020) and year 5 (2021) but the list has not been finalized or approved by the Board at this time.
Why was Josey not on the list for year 3? Can we see renderings for Josey ES? When will Josey ES open?	Josey was originally approved as a year 2 project but after the updated demographic study was released, the project was pushed out one year and plans to August 2021. The renderings will be uploaded to the bond website.
How has enrollment trended for Kindergarteners as compared to the demographic study?	Kindergarten is always the most difficult to predict, especially campus to campus. As a district, our kindergarten numbers are within 1% of projection, which is the goal.
Demographers have missed for a number of years. We need to be more aggressive discussing charter schools with legislators.	Demographers are having an increasingly difficult time with the rise of schools of choice. Two years ago, our projections were significantly higher than actual numbers. As we looked closely at the numbers from two years ago, we saw a dramatic, unexpected, and inexplicable drop in single family home yields. Templeton has worked with us to re-evaluate their projection tool, and this year we have actually exceeded projections by 1.14%.
Have we looked at the property off of 407 (Marjorie Vickery property) and if it will affect demographics? Toll Brothers may have purchased it and is building a large new development on that land?	That property is built into long-range numbers and is being monitored. There will be an impact based on what type of home and what price point is used as it gets closer.
