- Be surrounded by gifted people with a shared interest in academics, fine arts, or languages!








### General Requirements For Honor Societies

- For some honor societies, having no disciplinary referrals and having prior documented community service/involvement may be required









# National Honor Society (NHS)


Mission: To elevate a school's commitment to the values of scholarship, service, leadership, and character










