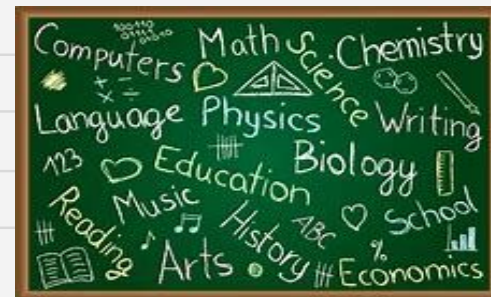
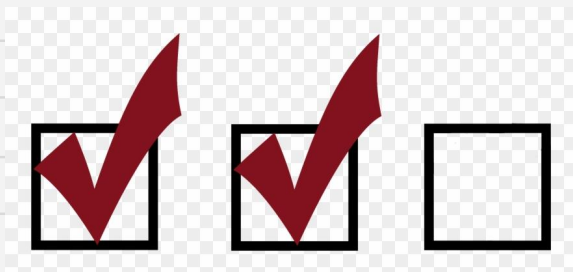
# Why Join Honor Societies?

- For some honor societies, having no disciplinary referrals and having prior documented community service/involvement may be required

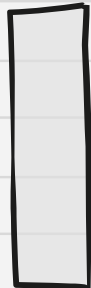
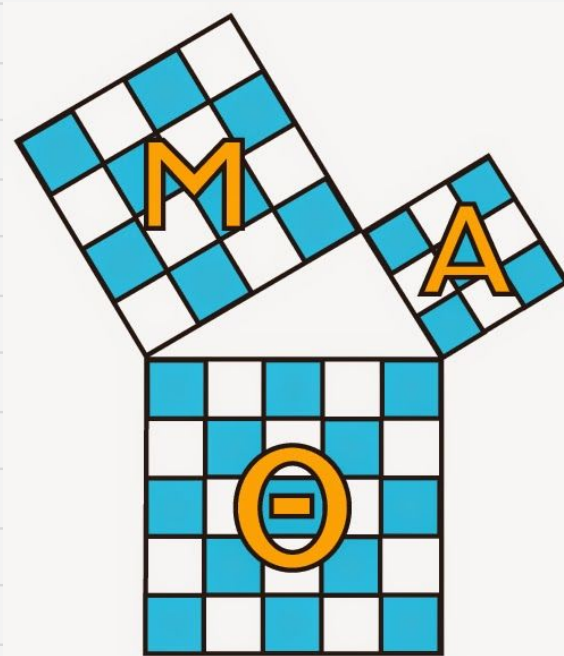

# National Honor Society (NHS)

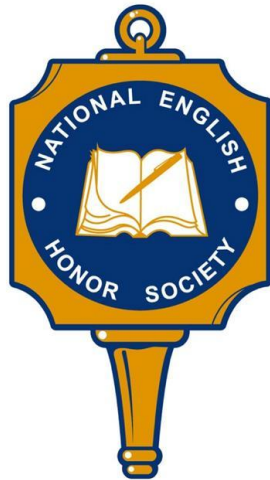

Mission: To inspire a keen interest in mathematics, develop strong scholarship in the subject, and promote the enjoyment of mathematics in high school students.

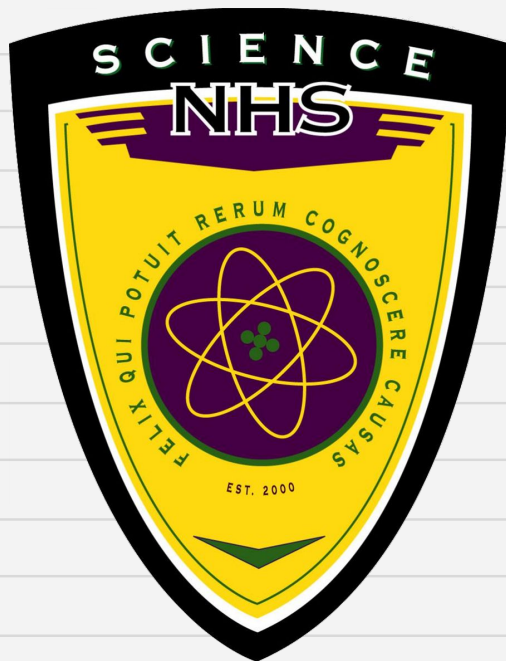


# National English Honor Society (NEHS)

## National Art Honor Society/Art Club



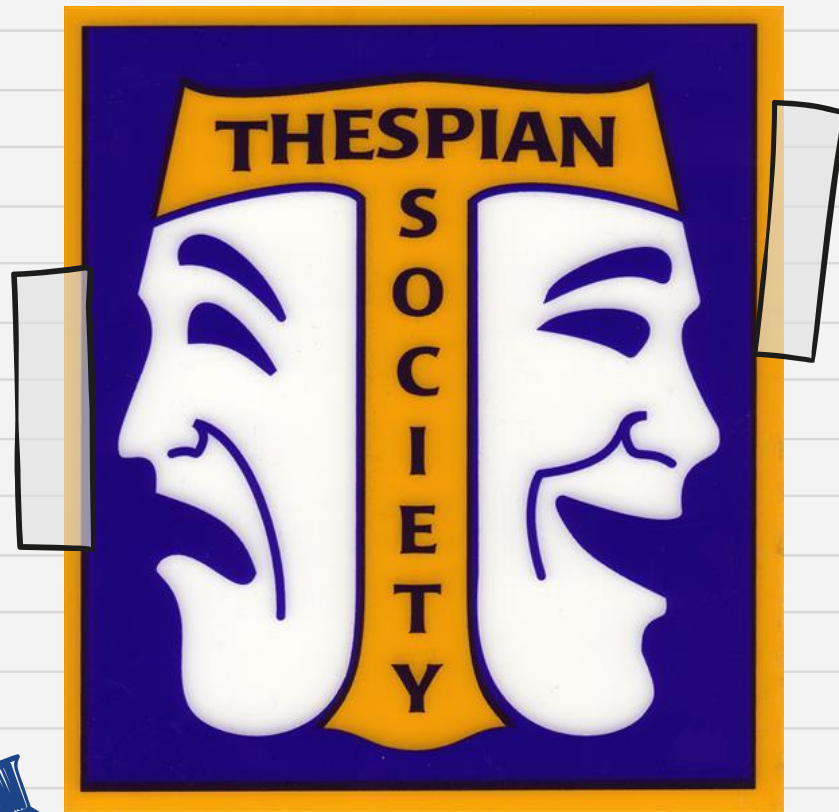
Mission: To create a collaborative space for artistic minds and an opportunity to reach out and build a creative community through service and volunteering

# Spanish Honor Society (SHH)

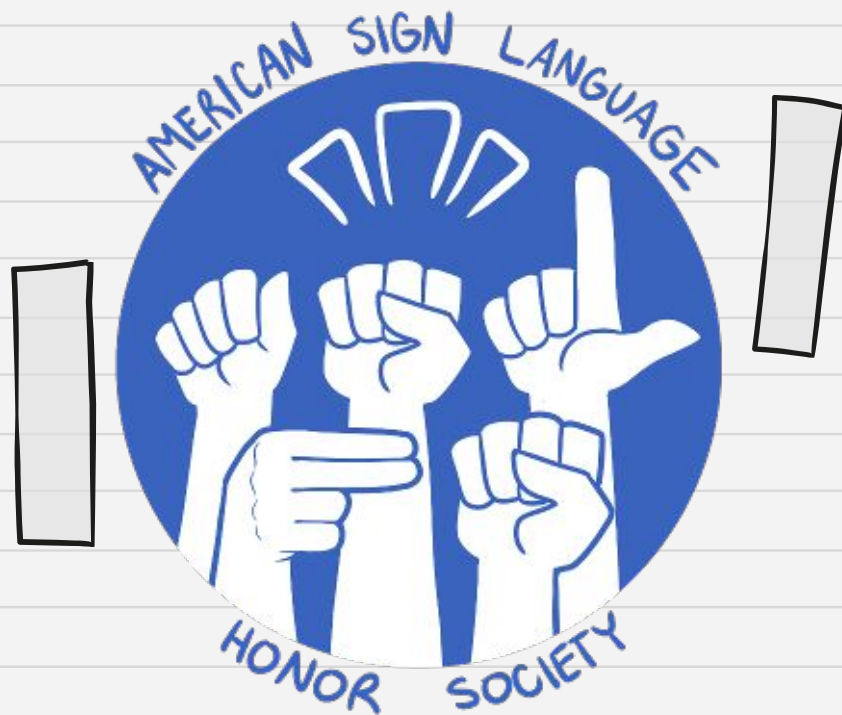
